Organizational setting and Reporting:

The post is located in the Office of the Prosecutor of the International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals (IRMCT), Arusha Branch. The incumbent will work under the general supervision of the Legal Officer.

Only candidates under consideration will be contacted. The selected candidate will be offered a consultant's contract.

I. Scope

These terms of reference define the duties and parameters of Consultants' engaged by the IRMCT-OTP for a period of two to three months.

II. Duties

The CIC will execute duties assigned to her/him by senior staff of the OTP including Legal Officers, Investigators and Records Management Staff. Specifically, these are:

- a. Conduct legal research on various questions of international criminal law, including but not limited to applications for review of judgment, contempt of the Tribunal/Mechanism;
- b. Conduct legal research on the jurisprudence of the ICTR/ICTY/IRMCT on various question of international criminal law and international humanitarian law, including on the Statute and Rules of the ICTR/ICTY/IRMCT;
- c. Draft and submit legal opinion on all legal research assignments completed;
- d. Update the ICTR/ICTY/IRMCT Appeals Chamber's Digest;
- e. Participate in in-house training conducted by Information Management Officer on the usage of OTP databases;
- f. On instructions from the Investigators and Legal Officers, upload data in the Case Map database;
- g. Perform any other duties as may be assigned from time to time.

III. Confidentiality

- a. Keep confidential, any information to which she has access in the course of the consultancy;
- b. Any written work which contains information obtained during the consultancy shall not be published without prior explicit authorization from the Registrar of the Mechanism.

IV. Completion of Consultancy

- a. Consultants must provide written notice to their supervisor(s) should illness or other unforeseen circumstances prevent them from completing the consultancy;
- b. There is no expectancy of employment by the United Nations at the end of the consultancy, and the consultant cannot apply for a regular position in the Mechanism or the UN Secretariat during the period of the consultancy or six months immediately following the expiration of the date thereof;
- c. On completion of the Consultancy contract, Consultants are required to complete a substantive report on their assignments. This will be included in their files and will be forwarded, upon request, to the referral institution, government body or private organization.

V. Fees

- a. Consultants shall be paid a fee at the rate of \$500 per month, payable at the end of each month.
